I-264 East Downtown Tunnel: Alternating lane closures in the Downtown Tunnel eastbound on Sunday, February 4 from 6 a.m. to 10 a.m.

I-264 West Downtown Tunnel: Alternating lane closures in the Downtown Tunnel westbound on Sunday, February 4 from 6 a.m. to 10 a.m.

I-264 West Downtown Tunnel: Right lane closure in the Downtown Tunnel westbound on Monday, February 5 from 8 p.m. until 5 a.m. the following morning.

I-264 West Downtown Tunnel: Right lane closure in the Downtown Tunnel westbound on Tuesday, February 6 from 8 p.m. until 12 a.m. (midnight)

I-264 East Downtown Tunnel: Right lane closure from Effingham St. through the Downtown Tunnel eastbound on Wednesday, February 7 from 8 p.m. to 12 a.m. (midnight)



US 58 East Midtown Tunnel: Alternating lane closures in the Midtown Tunnel eastbound on Sunday, February 4 from 6 a.m. to 10 a.m.

US 58 West Midtown Tunnel: Alternating lane closures in the Midtown Tunnel westbound on Sunday, February 4 from 6 a.m. to 10 a.m.

US 58 East: All eastbound traffic through the Midtown Tunnel to Brambleton Ave. will be stopped for 10-15 minutes during 3-4 intermittent closures between the hours of 12 a.m. and 3 a.m. on Tuesday, February 6.

US 58 West Midtown Tunnel: Right lane closure in the Midtown Tunnel westbound on

US 58 East Midtown Tunnel: Right lane closure in the Midtown Tunnel eastbound on
