**US 58 East Midtown Tunnel:** Alternating lane closures in the Midtown Tunnel eastbound on Monday, September 16; Tuesday, September 17; Wednesday, September 18; and Thursday, September 19 from 8 p.m. to 5 a.m. the following morning.



**I-264 East:** Left lane closures on I-264 between Frederick Blvd. and Effingham St. eastbound on Monday, September 16; Tuesday, September 17; Wednesday, September 18; and Thursday, September 19 from 7 p.m. to 5 a.m. the following morning.

**I-264 West:** Left lane closures on I-264 between Effingham St. and Frederick Blvd. westbound on Monday, September 16; Tuesday, September 17; Wednesday, September 18; and Thursday, September 19 from 7 p.m. to 5 a.m. the following morning.



**VA 164 West:** Left lane closure on VA 164 West from a half-mile before London Blvd. westbound to the West Norfolk Bridge on Monday, September 16; Tuesday, September 17; Wednesday, September 18; and Thursday, September 19 from 8 p.m. to 5 a.m. the following morning.

**VA 164 East:** Alternating lane closures on VA 164 East from the West Norfolk Bridge to a half-mile after London Blvd. eastbound on Sunday, September 15 and Monday, September 16 from 8 p.m. to 5 a.m. the following morning.

**VA 164 West:** Left lane closure on VA 164 East from the West Norfolk Bridge to a half-mile after London Blvd. westbound. on Tuesday, September 17; Wednesday, September 18; and Thursday, September 19 from 8 p.m. to 5 a.m. the following morning.
