Temporary Closure at the Midtown Tunnel Eastbound

Friday, September 6

Due to the potential impacts of Hurricane Dorian, the Midtown Tunnel eastbound will be temporarily closed on Friday, September 6, starting at 11 a.m. This is a precautionary measure to ensure the safety of the traveling public. Alternate routes motorists can take include the Downtown Tunnel, the I-64 High Rise Bridge or the South Norfolk Jordan Bridge.

[Elizabeth River Crossings](#) (ERC) is closely monitoring the progression of Hurricane Dorian and our Operations and Maintenance teams are coordinating with VDOT and our local communities on preparedness for any potential impacts of the storm.
